Based on information as supplied by our raw material vendors and Haysite's formulations used in our products, the concentration levels of the chemicals and compounds listed, are not present or are below the maximum concentration value of 0.1% by weight in homogeneous material for the ROHS list, which includes lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB and PBDE, cadmium, PCBs, octabromodiphenyl, decabromodiphenyl.

Based on information as supplied by our raw material vendors and Haysite's formulations used in our products, all Haysite products are compliant to the REACH Directive for the list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC).
